3 **SECTION 1. TERMINATION OF THE NATIONAL EDUCATION**

4 **COMMISSION ON TIME AND LEARNING.**

5 Subsection (g) of section 102 of the National Edu-  
6 cation Commission on Time and Learning Act (20 U.S.C.  
7 1221-1 note) is amended by striking “90 days after sub-  
8 mitting the final report required by subsection (d)” and  
9 inserting “on September 30, 1994”.
