Mr. WARNER (for himself and Mr. ROBB) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Banking, Housing, and Urban Affairs

A BILL

To amend the Water Supply Act of 1958 to provide for the funding of capital improvements at the Washington Aqueduct, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS AT WASHINGTON**
4 **AQUEDUCT.**

5 Section 301 of the Water Supply Act of 1958 (43
6 U.S.C. 390b) is amended by adding at the end the follow-
7 ing new subsection:

8 “(e) Notwithstanding any other provision of law—

1 “(1) the Chief of Engineers of the Army Corps
2 of Engineers may borrow from the Federal Financ-
3 ing Bank such amounts as the Chief determines are
4 necessary to finance capital improvements at the
5 Washington Aqueduct;

6 “(2) upon request of the Chief, the Board of
7 Directors of the Federal Financing Bank shall make
8 loans to the Chief for the purpose described in para-
9 graph (1); and

10 “(3) any amounts borrowed by the Chief under
11 this subsection shall be repaid by users of the Wash-
12 ington Aqueduct over such period of time, and shall
13 be subject to such other terms and conditions, as the
14 Board determines to be appropriate.”.

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
