Mr. SARBANES introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

For the relief of Maria Manzano.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the Secretary of the Treasury shall pay, out of
4 money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, to
5 Maria Manzano of Temple Hills, Maryland, the sum of
6 \$20,228.25, in full settlement of all claims of Maria
7 Manzano against the United States arising out of the im-
8 proper disclosure of the records of the grievance proceed-
9 ings brought in 1971 by an employee of the Laboratory
10 Division of the Department of State asserting a complaint
11 against Maria Manzano, a supervisor in such division.

1 SEC. 2. Nothing in this Act shall be construed to give
2 rise to an inference of liability on the part of the United
3 States.

4 SEC. 3. (a) No part of the amount appropriated by
5 the first section of this Act in excess of 10 percent thereof
6 shall be paid or delivered to or received by any agent or
7 attorney on account of services rendered in connection
8 with the enactment of this Act, any contract to the con-
9 trary notwithstanding.

10 (b) A violation of this section is a misdemeanor pun-
11 ishable by a fine in an amount not exceeding \$1,000.
