Mr. MACK introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources

A BILL

To authorize Escambia County, Florida, to convey certain lands in Florida to a political subdivision of the State of Florida, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION OF CONVEYANCE TO POLITI-**
4 **CAL SUBDIVISION OF STATE OF FLORIDA.**

5 Notwithstanding the Act of July 30, 1946 (60 Stat.
6 712, chapter 699) that provides that the lands described
7 in such Act may be conveyed by Escambia County, Flor-
8 ida, only by lease or to the Federal Government, the State
9 of Florida, or an agency of the State of Florida, the lands
10 described in such Act may be conveyed by Escambia Coun-

1 ty, Florida, to a political subdivision of the State of
2 Florida.

3 **SEC. 2. ACTIONS BY SECRETARY OF THE INTERIOR.**

4 Not later than 180 days after the date of the enact-
5 ment of this Act, the Secretary of the Interior shall exe-
6 cute and file in the appropriate repository of public
7 records a deed or other appropriate instrument, if any,
8 that is necessary to document the authority of Escambia
9 County, Florida, to convey real property in accordance
10 with section 1.
