Mr. BUMPERS introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Environment and Public Works

A BILL

To require the Secretary of the Interior to convey the Corning National Fish Hatchery to the State of Arkansas.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Corning National Fish
5 Hatchery Conveyance Act of 1994”.

6 **SEC. 2. CONVEYANCE OF THE CORNING NATIONAL FISH**
7 **HATCHERY TO THE STATE OF ARKANSAS.**

8 (a) CONVEYANCE REQUIREMENT.—The Secretary of
9 the Interior shall convey to the State of Arkansas, without
10 reimbursement and by no later than December 31, 1994,

1 all right, title, and interest of the United States in and
2 to the property described in subsection (b), for use by the
3 Arkansas Game and Fish Commission as part of the State
4 of Arkansas fish culture program.

5 (b) PROPERTY DESCRIBED.—The property referred
6 to in subsection (a) is the property formally known as the
7 Corning National Fish Hatchery, and now known as the
8 William H. Donham State Fish Hatchery, located one mile
9 west of Corning, Arkansas, on Arkansas State Highway
10 67 in Clay County, Arkansas, consisting of 137.34 acres,
11 (more or less) and all improvements and related personal
12 property under the control of the Secretary that is located
13 on that property, including buildings, structures, and
14 equipment.

15 (c) REVERSIONARY INTEREST OF UNITED STATES.—
16 If after the conveyance required by subsection (a) any of
17 the property described in subsection (b) is used for pur-
18 poses other than as described in subsection (a), all right,
19 title, and interest conveyed under this section shall revert
20 to the United States.
