A BILL

To expand the boundary of the Weir Farm National Historic Site in the State of Connecticut.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Weir Farm National
5 Historic Site Expansion Act of 1994”.

1 **SEC. 2. PURPOSE.**

2 The purpose of this Act is to preserve the last re-
 3 maining undeveloped parcels of the historic Weir Farm
 4 that remain in private ownership by including the parcels
 5 within the boundary of the Weir Farm National Historic
 6 Site.

7 **SEC. 3. BOUNDARY ADJUSTMENT.**

8 (a) ADJUSTMENT.—Section 4(b) of the Weir Farm
 9 National Historic Site Establishment Act of 1990 (~~104~~
 10 ~~Stat. 1171~~) (*Public Law 101-485; 104 Stat. 1171*) is
 11 amended—

12 (1) by striking out “and” at the end of para-
 13 graph (1);

14 (2) by striking out the flush material below
 15 paragraph (2); and

16 (3) by adding at the end the following:

17 “(3) the approximately 2-acre parcel of land sit-
 18 uated in the town of Wilton, Connecticut, designated
 19 as lot 18 on a map entitled ‘Revised Map of Section
 20 I, Thunder Lake at Wilton, Connecticut, Scale 1”=
 21 100’, October 27, 1978, Ryan and Faulds Land
 22 Surveyors, Wilton, Connecticut’, that is on file in the
 23 office of the town clerk of the town of Wilton, and
 24 therein numbered 3673; and

25 “(4) the approximately ~~0.6-acre~~ .9-acre western
 26 portion of a parcel of land situated in the town of

1 Wilton, Connecticut, designated as Tall Oaks Road
2 on the map referred to in paragraph (3).”.

3 (b) GENERAL DEPICTION.—Section 4 of such Act, as
4 amended by subsection (a), is further amended by adding
5 at the end the following:

6 “(c) GENERAL DEPICTION.—The parcels referred to
7 in paragraphs (1) through (4) of subsection (b) are all
8 as generally depicted on a map entitled ‘Boundary Map,
9 Weir Farm National Historic Site’, ~~dated March 1994.~~
10 *Site, Fairfield County Connecticut’, dated June, 1994.*
11 Such map shall be on file and available for public inspec-
12 tion in the appropriate offices of the National Park
13 Service.”.
