AN ACT

To elevate the position of Director of Indian Health Service to Assistant Secretary of Health and Human Services, to provide for the organizational independence of the Indian Health Service within the Department of Health and Human Services, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. OFFICE OF ASSISTANT SECRETARY FOR INDIAN**
4 **HEALTH.**

5 (a) ESTABLISHMENT.—There is established within
6 the Department of Health and Human Services the Office
7 of the Assistant Secretary for Indian Health.

8 (b) ASSISTANT SECRETARY OF INDIAN HEALTH.—
9 In addition to the functions performed on the date of en-
10 actment of this Act by the Director of the Indian Health

1 Service, the Assistant Secretary for Indian Health shall
2 perform such functions as the Secretary of Health and
3 Human Services may designate.

4 (c) REFERENCES.—Reference in any other Federal
5 law, Executive order, rule, regulation, or delegation of au-
6 thority, or any document of or relating to the Director
7 of the Indian Health Service shall be deemed to refer the
8 Assistant Secretary for Indian Health.

9 (d) RATE OF PAY.—(1) Section 5315 of title 5, Unit-
10 ed States Code, is amended by striking the following:

11 “Assistant Secretaries of Health and Human
12 Services (5).”;

13 and inserting the following:

14 “Assistant Secretaries of Health and Human
15 Services (6).”.

16 (2) Section 5316 of such title is amended by striking
17 the following:

18 “Director, Indian Health Service, Department
19 of Health and Human Services.”.

20 (e) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—(1) Section 601 of
21 the Indian Health Care Improvement Act (25 U.S.C.
22 1661) is amended—

23 (A) in the second sentence of subsection (a), by
24 striking “a Director,” and inserting “the Assistant
25 Secretary for Indian Health,”;

1 (B) in the fourth sentence of subsection (a), by
2 striking “the Director” and inserting “the Assistant
3 Secretary for Indian Health”;

4 (C) by striking out the fifth sentence of sub-
5 section (a); and

6 (D) by striking “Director of the Indian Health
7 Service” each place it appears and inserting “Assist-
8 ant Secretary for Indian Health”.

9 (2) The following provisions are amended by striking
10 “Director of the Indian Health Service” each place it ap-
11 pears and inserting “Assistant Secretary for Indian
12 Health”:

13 (A) Section 816(c)(1) of the Indian Health
14 Care Improvement Act (25 U.S.C. 1680f(c)(1)).

15 (B) Section 203(a)(1) of the Rehabilitation Act
16 of 1973 (29 U.S.C. 761b(a)(1)).

17 (C) Subsections (b) and (e) of section 518 of
18 the Federal Water Pollution Control Act (33 U.S.C.
19 1377(b), (e)).

20 (D) Section 803B(d)(1) of the Native American
21 Programs Act of 1974 (42 U.S.C. 2991b-2(d)(1)).

1 **SEC. 2. ORGANIZATION OF INDIAN HEALTH SERVICE WITH-**
2 **IN DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN**
3 **SERVICES.**

4 (a) ORGANIZATION.—Section 601 of the Indian
5 Health Care Improvement Act (25 U.S.C. 1661), as
6 amended by section 1(e)(1), is further amended—

7 (1) by striking out “within the Public Health
8 Service of the Department of Health and Human
9 Services” each place it appears and inserting “with-
10 in the Department of Health and Human Services”;
11 and

12 (2) in the second sentence of subsection (a), by
13 striking out “report to the Secretary through the
14 Assistant Secretary for Health of the Department of
15 Health and Human Services” and inserting “report
16 to the Secretary”.

17 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—The section head-
18 ing of such section is amended by striking the following:
19 “ESTABLISHMENT OF THE INDIAN HEALTH SERVICE AS
20 AN AGENCY OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH SERVICE”;

21 and inserting the following:

22 “ESTABLISHMENT OF THE INDIAN HEALTH SERVICE AS
23 AN AGENCY OF DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND
24 HUMAN SERVICES”.

25 (c) UTILIZATION OF PUBLIC HEALTH SERVICE PER-
26 SONNEL.—The Secretary shall provide for the utilization

1 by the Indian Health Service of officers or employees of
2 the Public Health Service for the purposes of carrying out
3 the responsibilities of the Indian Health Service. Any offi-
4 cers or employees so utilized shall be treated as officers
5 or employees detailed to an executive department under
6 section 214(a) of the Public Health Service (42 U.S.C.
7 215(a)).
