A BILL

To ensure that no person is required, other than on a vol-
untary basis, to complete certain quarterly financial re-
ports of the Bureau of the Census.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REGULATIONS.**

4 Not later than 120 days after the date of the enact-
5 ment of this Act, the Secretary of Commerce shall issue
6 such regulations as may be necessary to ensure that no
7 person is required, other than on a voluntary basis, to
8 complete or submit to the Bureau of the Census, or any
9 other Federal department, agency or instrumentality,
10 form QFR-101, QFR-101A, QFR-102, or QFR-103 of

1 the Bureau of the Census, or any successor form to such
2 form, unless such person is entitled, under such regula-
3 tions, to fair and reasonable monetary compensation based
4 on the time and effort required to complete such form.
