2 States in which it is incorporated and subject to the laws  
3 of such State or States.

4 OBJECTS AND PURPOSES OF CORPORATION

5 SEC. 3. The objects and purposes of the corporation  
6 are those provided in its articles of incorporation and shall  
7 include—

8 (1) the promotion of fellowship among its mem-  
9 bers;

10 (2) the perpetuation of the record of the 29th  
11 Division, United States Army, in the World Wars;

12 (3) the promotion of the welfare of its mem-  
13 bers, their families, and the families of the members  
14 of the Division who lost their lives in the service of  
15 Our Country;

16 (4) the consideration of questions concerning  
17 the military policy of the United States of America;  
18 and

19 (5) to uphold and defend the Constitution of  
20 the United States of America.

21 SERVICE OF PROCESS

22 SEC. 4. With respect to service of process, the cor-  
23 poration shall comply with the laws of the State or States  
24 in which it is incorporated and the State or States in  
25 which it carries on its activities in furtherance of its cor-  
26 porate purposes.

## 1 MEMBERSHIP

2 SEC. 5. (a) Subject to subsection (b), eligibility for  
3 membership in the corporation and the rights and privi-  
4 leges of members of the corporation shall be as provided  
5 in the constitution and bylaws of the corporation.

6 (b) Terms of membership and requirements for hold-  
7 ing office within the corporation shall not discriminate on  
8 the basis of race, color, national origin, sex, religion, or  
9 handicapped status.

## 10 BOARD OF DIRECTORS; COMPOSITION; RESPONSIBILITIES

11 SEC. 6. The composition of the board of directors of  
12 the corporation and the responsibilities of such board shall  
13 be as provided in the articles of incorporation of the cor-  
14 poration and shall be in conformity with the laws of the  
15 State or States in which it is incorporated.

## 16 OFFICERS OF CORPORATION

17 SEC. 7. The positions of officers of the corporation  
18 and the election of members to such positions shall be as  
19 provided in the articles of incorporation of the corporation  
20 and shall be in conformity with the laws of the State or  
21 States in which it is incorporated.

## 22 RESTRICTIONS

23 SEC. 8. (a) No part of the income or assets of the  
24 corporation may inure to the benefit of any member, offi-  
25 cer, or director of the corporation or be distributed to any  
26 such individual during the life of this charter. Nothing in

1 this subsection shall be construed to prevent the payment  
2 of reasonable compensation to the officers of the corpora-  
3 tion or reimbursement for actual and necessary expenses  
4 in amounts approved by the board of directors.

5 (b) The corporation may not make any loan to any  
6 officer, director, or employee of the corporation.

7 (c) The corporation may not contribute to, support,  
8 or otherwise participate in any political activity or attempt  
9 in any manner to influence legislation. No officer or direc-  
10 tor of the corporation, acting as such officer or director,  
11 may commit any act prohibited under this subsection.

12 (d) The corporation shall have no power to issue any  
13 shares of stock nor to declare or pay any dividends.

14 (e) The corporation shall not claim congressional ap-  
15 proval or Federal Government authority for any of its  
16 activities.

17 LIABILITY

18 SEC. 9. The corporation shall be liable for the acts  
19 of its officers and agents whenever such officers and  
20 agents have acted within the scope of their authority.

21 BOOKS AND RECORDS; INSPECTION

22 SEC. 10. The corporation shall keep correct and com-  
23 plete books and records of account and minutes of any  
24 proceeding of the corporation involving any of its mem-  
25 bers, the board of directors, or any committee having au-  
26 thority under the board of directors. The corporation shall

1 keep, at its principal office, a record of the names and  
2 addresses of all members having the right to vote in any  
3 proceeding of the corporation. All books and records of  
4 such corporation may be inspected by any member having  
5 the right to vote in any corporation proceeding, or by any  
6 agent or attorney of such member, for any proper purpose  
7 at any reasonable time. Nothing in this section shall be  
8 construed to contravene any applicable State law.

9                   AUDIT OF FINANCIAL TRANSACTIONS

10       SEC. 11. The first section of the Act entitled “An  
11 Act to provide for audit of accounts of private corporations  
12 established under Federal law”, approved August 30,  
13 1964 (36 U.S.C. 1101), is amended by adding at the end  
14 thereof the following:

15                   “(74) 29th Division Association, Incor-  
16                   porated.”.

17                   ANNUAL REPORT

18       SEC. 12. The corporation shall report annually to the  
19 Congress concerning the activities of the corporation dur-  
20 ing the preceding fiscal year. Such annual report shall be  
21 submitted at the same time as the report of the audit of  
22 the corporation required by section 2 of the Act entitled  
23 “An Act to provide for audit of accounts of private cor-  
24 porations established under Federal law”, approved Au-  
25 gust 30, 1964 (36 U.S.C. 1101). The report shall not be  
26 printed as a public document.

1 RESERVATION OF RIGHT TO AMEND, ALTER, OR REPEAL  
2 CHARTER

3 SEC. 13. The right to amend, alter, or repeal this Act  
4 is expressly reserved to the Congress.

5 DEFINITION OF STATE

6 SEC. 14. For purposes of this Act, the term “State”  
7 includes the District of Columbia, the Commonwealth of  
8 Puerto Rico, the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana  
9 Islands, and the territories and possessions of the United  
10 States.

11 TAX-EXEMPT STATUS

12 SEC. 15. The corporation shall maintain its status as  
13 an organization exempt from taxation as provided in the  
14 Internal Revenue Code of 1986.

15 TERMINATION

16 SEC. 16. If the corporation fails to comply with any  
17 of the restrictions or provisions of this Act, the charter  
18 granted by this Act shall expire.
