Mr. HATCH introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources

A BILL

To define certain terms for purposes of the Federal Land Policy and Management Act of 1976, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Local Government
5 Planning Involvement Act of 1994”.

6 **SEC. 2. LOCAL GOVERNMENT ENTITY.**

7 Section 103(b) of the Federal Land Policy and Man-
8 agement Act of 1976 (43 U.S.C. 1702(b)) is amended by
9 adding at the end the following: “For purposes of the
10 preceding sentence, the term ‘local government entity’

1 means a local political entity created or recognized pursu-
2 ant to State law, including—

3 “(1) county commissions;

4 “(2) special service districts;

5 “(3) water districts;

6 “(4) cities;

7 “(5) towns; and

8 “(6) regional and local government associa-
9 tions.”.

10 **SEC. 3. COORDINATION.**

11 Section 202(c)(9) of the Federal Land Policy and
12 Management Act of 1976 (43 U.S.C. 1712(c)(9)) is
13 amended by inserting after “land resource management
14 programs.” the following: “Such coordination shall include
15 (A) notification by the Secretary to Governors of States
16 and heads of local governments of the intent or plan to
17 conduct land use surveys, inventories, studies, and plan-
18 ning; (B) inclusion of State and local government employ-
19 ees in all inventory, planning, and management activities
20 upon request by the heads of State and local governments;
21 and (C) making available, upon request by the heads of
22 State and local governments, regulations, inventories,
23 management plans, and long- and short-term work plans
24 relating to Federal land use and management during their
25 preparation.”.
