Mrs. BOXER (for herself and Mrs. FEINSTEIN) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Environment and Public Works

A BILL

To require the Secretary of the Treasury to transfer to the Administrator of General Services the Old U.S. Mint in San Francisco, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TRANSFER OF U.S. MINT, SAN FRANCISCO.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
5 sion of law, not later than 1 year after the date of enact-
6 ment of this Act, the Secretary of the Treasury shall
7 transfer to the Administrator of General Services, without
8 consideration, the property referred to as the “Old U.S.
9 Mint”, located at Fifth and Mission Streets, San Fran-

1 cisco, California, together with any improvements, struc-
2 tures, and fixtures located on the property.

3 (b) OBTAINING OF OTHER SPACE.—Notwithstanding
4 any other provision of law, using authority and funds
5 available under section 5134 of title 31, United States
6 Code, the Secretary of the Treasury may obtain by lease
7 or purchase other space for the operations of the United
8 States Mint carried out, prior to the date of transfer under
9 subsection (a), at the Old U.S. Mint.

10 (c) SPACE AND SERVICES CHARGES.—

11 (1) IN GENERAL.—In accordance with section
12 210(j) of the Federal Property and Administrative
13 Services Act of 1949 (40 U.S.C. 490(j)), the Admin-
14 istrator of General Services shall charge persons who
15 are furnished space and services in connection with
16 the property transferred under subsection (a) for the
17 space and services.

18 (2) DEPOSIT OF CHARGES COLLECTED.—Not-
19 withstanding any other provision of law, the Admin-
20 istrator of General Services shall deposit in the Fed-
21 eral Buildings Fund established by section 210(f) of
22 such Act the amounts collected under paragraph (1).
