A BILL

To require the Administrator of the Environmental Protection Agency to make grants for the construction of certain treatment works, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. GRANTS FOR CONSTRUCTION OF CERTAIN**
4 **TREATMENT WORKS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Administrator of the Envi-
6 ronmental Protection Agency shall make 1 or more grants
7 in accordance with title II of the Federal Water Pollution
8 Control Act (33 U.S.C. 1281 et seq.) for the construction

1 of publicly owned treatment works in the South Valley of
2 Bernalillo County, New Mexico.

3 (b) FUNDING.—The Administrator is authorized to
4 use \$25,000,000 of the funds made available to the Envi-
5 ronmental Protection Agency under the matter under the
6 heading “WATER INFRASTRUCTURE/STATE REVOLVING
7 FUNDS” under the heading “ENVIRONMENTAL PROTEC-
8 TION AGENCY” in title III of the Departments of Veterans
9 Affairs and Housing and Urban Development, and Inde-
10 pendent Agencies Appropriations Act, 1994 (Public Law
11 103–124; 107 Stat. 1294), to carry out this section, to
12 remain available until expended.

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
