A BILL

To reimburse municipalities for tax liens which had been placed on forfeited property.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ASSET FORFEITURE.**

4 (a) Section 524 of title 28, United States Code, is
5 amended—

6 (1) by redesignating subsection (c)(1)(H) to be
7 subsection (c)(1)(I); and

8 (2) by inserting a new subsection (c)(1)(H) as
9 follows:

1 “(H) the payment of State and local prop-
2 erty taxes on forfeited real property that ac-
3 crued between the date of the violation giving
4 rise to the forfeiture and the date of the forfeit-
5 ure order; and”.

6 (b) The provisions of this section shall apply to all
7 claims pending at the time of or commenced subsequent
8 to the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
