Mr. FORD introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To provide for the appointment of 1 additional Federal district judge for the western district of Kentucky, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ADDITIONAL FEDERAL DISTRICT JUDGE FOR**
4 **THE WESTERN DISTRICT OF KENTUCKY.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The President shall appoint, by
6 and with the advice and consent of the Senate, 1 addi-
7 tional district judge for the western district of Kentucky.

8 (b) EASTERN DISTRICT.—The district judgeship for
9 the eastern and western districts of Kentucky (as in effect
10 before the date of the enactment of this Act) shall be a

1 district judgeship for the eastern district of Kentucky
2 only, and the incumbent of such judgeship shall hold his
3 office under section 133 of title 28, United States Code,
4 as amended by this section.

5 (c) TABLES.—In order that the table contained in
6 section 133 of title 28, United States Code, shall reflect
7 the change in the total number of permanent district
8 judgeships authorized under this section, such table is
9 amended by amending the item relating to Kentucky to
10 read as follows:

“Kentucky:	
“Eastern	5
“Western	5”.
