Mr. HEFLIN introduced the following bill; which was read twice, considered,  
read the third time, and passed

## A BILL

To prohibit the duplication of benefits.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. PROHIBITION AGAINST DUPLICATION OF**  
4       **BENEFITS.**

5       The 1994 Disaster Assistance provision as contained  
6       in the Agriculture Rural Development, Food and Drug  
7       Administration, and Related Agencies Act, 1995, is  
8       amended by adding at the end of the following new para-  
9       graph:

10       “(10) LIMITATION ON DISASTER PAYMENTS.—

11       The Secretary shall adjust the amount of disaster  
12       payments made to a producer for a crop of peanuts

1 to ensure that the total amount of quota poundage  
2 for which such payments are made to the producer  
3 plus the amount of quota poundage produced and  
4 marketed by the producer does not exceed the effec-  
5 tive poundage quota for the farm of the producer for  
6 that crop. Disaster payments to a producer on  
7 poundage quota in excess of the effective quota for  
8 the farm of the producer shall be made based on the  
9 additional poundage payment rate.”.
