2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. IMPLEMENTATION OF OIL POLLUTION ACT**  
4 **WITH RESPECT TO ANIMAL FATS AND VEGE-**  
5 **TABLE OILS.**

6 In implementing the Oil Pollution Act of 1990 (Pub-  
7 lic Law 101-380), Federal agencies shall differentiate be-  
8 tween animal fats or oils of vegetable origin and other oils,  
9 including petroleum oils, on the basis of their physical,
