1 **SECTION 1. REPORTING AND STAGGERED ISSUANCE FOR**
2 **HOUSEHOLDS ON RESERVATIONS.**

5 of 1977 (7 U.S.C. 2015(c)(1)(A)) is amended—

9 (b) STAGGERED ISSUANCES ON RESERVATIONS.—
10 Section 7(h)(1) of such Act (7 U.S.C. 2016(h)(1)) is
11 amended by striking the second sentence.

12 (c) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—

13 (1) Subtitle A of title IX of the Food, Agri-
14 culture, Conservation, and Trade Act Amendments
15 of 1991 (Public Law 102–237) is amended by re-
16 pealing section 908.

17 (2) Section 5(f)(2)(C) of the Food Stamp Act
18 of 1977 (7 U.S.C. 2014(f)(2)(C)) is amended by
19 striking “(iii), and (iv)” and inserting “and (iii)”.
