To revise the boundaries of the George Washington
Birthplace National Monument, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. ADDITION TO NATIONAL MONUMENT.**

2 The boundaries of the George Washington Birthplace
3 National Monument (hereinafter referred to as the “Na-
4 tional Monument”) are hereby modified to include the
5 area comprising approximately 12 acres, as generally de-
6 picted on the map entitled “George Washington Birth-
7 place National Monument Boundary Map”, numbered
8 332/80,011A and dated September 1992, which shall be
9 on file and available for public inspection in the appro-
10 priate offices of the National Park Service, Department
11 of the Interior.

12 **SEC. 2. ACQUISITION OF LANDS.**

13 Within the boundaries of the National Monument, the
14 Secretary of the Interior (hereinafter referred to as the
15 “Secretary”) is authorized to acquire lands, or interests
16 therein, by donation, purchase with donated or appro-
17 priated funds, or exchange.

18 **SEC. 3. ADMINISTRATION OF NATIONAL MONUMENT.**

19 In administering the National Monument, the Sec-
20 retary shall take such action as is necessary to preserve
21 and interpret the history and resources associated with
22 George Washington, the generations of the Washington
23 family who lived in the vicinity, and their contemporaries,
24 as well as 18th century plantation life and society.

1 **SEC. 4. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

2 There are authorized to be appropriated such sums
3 as may be necessary to carry out this Act.
