## A BILL

3        **SECTION 1. PROTEST RELATING TO CERTAIN ENTRIES.**

4        For purposes of section 520 of the Tariff Act of 1930  
5        (19 U.S.C. 1520) and notwithstanding any other provision  
6        of law, Application No. 1001-0-201973, filed November  
7        8, 1990, shall be deemed to have been filed with the appro-  
8        priate customs officer within 1 year after the date of the
