## A BILL

To redesignate the Pulaski Post Office located at 111 West College Street in Pulaski, Tennessee, as the “Ross Bass Post Office”.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2        *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3        **SECTION 1. REDESIGNATION OF PULASKI POST OFFICE AS**  
4        **ROSS BASS POST OFFICE.**

5        The building in Pulaski, Tennessee that houses the  
6        primary operations of the United States Postal Service (as  
7        determined by the Postmaster General) shall be known  
8        and designated as the “Ross Bass Post Office Building”.  
9        Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document, paper,  
10       or other record of the United States to the building shall

- 1 be deemed to be a reference to the “Ross Bass Post Office
- 2 Building”.
