## A BILL

For the relief of Luis A. Gonzalez and Virginia Aguilla Gonzalez.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3       That, in the administration of the Immigration and Na-  
4       tionality Act, Luis A. Gonzalez and Virginia Aguilla Gon-  
5       zalez shall be held and considered to have been lawfully  
6       admitted to the United States for permanent residence as  
7       of the date of the enactment of this Act upon payment  
8       of the required visa fee. Upon the granting of permanent  
9       residence to such alien as provided for in this Act, the  
10      Secretary of State shall instruct the proper officer to re-  
11      duce by the proper number, during the current fiscal year

1 or the fiscal year next following, the total number of immi-  
2 grant visas and conditional entries which are made avail-  
3 able to natives of the country of the alien's birth under  
4 section 203(a) of the Immigration and Nationality Act,  
5 or if applicable, the total number of immigrant visas and  
6 conditional entries which are made available to natives of  
7 the country of the alien's birth under section 202(e) of  
8 such Act.
