## A BILL

For the relief of Armando Taube Moreno.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENCE.**

4 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, for pur-  
5 poses of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.  
6 1101 et seq.), Armando Taube Moreno shall be held and  
7 considered to have been lawfully admitted to the United  
8 States for permanent residence as of the date of the enact-  
9 ment of this Act upon payment of the required visa fee.

10 **SEC. 2. REDUCTION OF NUMBER OF AVAILABLE VISAS.**

11 Upon the granting of permanent residence to  
12 Armando Taube Moreno as provided in this Act, the Sec-

1   retary of State shall instruct the proper officer to reduce  
2   by one number during the current fiscal year the total  
3   number of immigrant visas available to natives of the  
4   country of the alien's birth under subsection (a) or (b)  
5   of section 203 of the Immigration and Nationality Act  
6   (8 U.S.C. 1153).
