## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on certain carbodiimide masterbatches.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN CARBODIIMIDE MASTERBATCHES.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
7 new heading:

9902.38.20	Masterbatches of poly[nitrilometh- anetraarylni-trilo]2,4,6- tris (1-methylethyl)- 1,3,phenylene]-[2,6bis(1- methylethyl)phenyl] omega[[[2,6bis(1- methylethyl) phenyl]amino] methylene]amino] or ben- zene, 2,4 diisocyanate- 1,3,5-tris (1-methylethyl) homopolymer with poly- ethylene, polyethylene terephthalate, or thermo- plastic polyurethane (pro- vided for in subheading 3812.30.40, 3901.10.00, 3907.60.00, or 3909.50.50)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/95	”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
2 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or  
3 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after  
4 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
