A BILL

To continue the authorization of appropriations for the East Court of the National Museum of Natural History, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION. 1. NATIONAL MUSEUM OF NATURAL HISTORY.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 2 of the Act entitled “An
5 Act to authorize the Board of Regents of the Smithsonian

1 Institution to plan, design, construct, and equip space in
2 the East Court of the National Museum of Natural His-
3 tory building, and for other purposes”, approved October
4 24, 1990 (20 U.S.C. 50 note), is amended by inserting
5 “and succeeding fiscal years” after “1991”.

6 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
7 subsection (a) shall take effect as of October 24, 1990.
