Mr. FORD introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to
the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

For the relief of land grantors in Henderson, Union, and
Webster Counties, Kentucky, and their heirs.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION.**

4 The Secretary of the Treasury is authorized and di-
5 rected to pay, out of money not otherwise appropriated,
6 to the individuals (and in any case in which such individ-
7 ual is deceased, the heirs of such individual) who sold their
8 land in Henderson, Union, and Webster Counties, Ken-
9 tucky, to the United States Government under threat of
10 condemnation in order to provide the 35,684.99 acres nec-

1 essary for the military training camp known as Camp
2 Breckinridge, the sum of \$ _____, such sum being
3 in full satisfaction of all claims by such individuals against
4 the United States arising out of such sale.

5 **SEC. 2. REASON FOR RELIEF.**

6 The individuals described in section 1 assert that they
7 were—

8 (1) promised they would be given priority to re-
9 purchase land sold by them if sold by the United
10 States Government; and

11 (2) paid less than reasonable value due in part
12 to the refusal of the United States Government to
13 compensate the owners for mineral, oil and gas
14 rights.

15 **SEC. 3. ATTORNEY FEES.**

16 No part of the amount appropriated by this Act in
17 excess of 10 percent thereof shall be paid or delivered to
18 or received by any agent or attorney on account of services
19 rendered in connection with this claim, any contract to the
20 contrary notwithstanding. Violation of the provisions of
21 this section is a misdemeanor punishable by a fine not to
22 exceed \$1,000.
