Mr. MOYNIHAN (for himself and Mr. D'AMATO) introduced the following bill;
which was read twice and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

For the relief of the estate of Dr. Beatrice Braude.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CONSENT TO SUIT.**

4 Notwithstanding any statute of limitations, lapse of
5 time, or bar of laches, the United States Court of Federal
6 Claims shall have jurisdiction to hear, determine, and
7 render judgment upon any claim for back pay by the es-
8 tate of Dr. Beatrice Braude against the United States
9 arising out of the termination of Dr. Braude's employment
10 at the United States Information Agency on December 30,
11 1953.

1 **SEC. 2. RESTRICTIONS UPON SUIT.**

2 Suit upon any claim referred to in section 1 may be
3 instituted at any time within 1 year after the date of en-
4 actment of this Act. Nothing in this Act shall be construed
5 as an inference of liability on the part of the United
6 States. Except as otherwise provided in this Act, proceed-
7 ings for the determination of such claims, and review and
8 payment of any judgment or judgments thereupon shall
9 be had in the same manner as in the case of claims over
10 which such court has jurisdiction under section 1491 of
11 title 28, United States Code.
