A BILL

For the relief of Nathan C. Vance, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PAYMENT TO NATHAN C. VANCE.**

4 (a) PAYMENT.—Subject to subsections (b) and (c),
5 the Secretary of Agriculture shall pay \$4,850.00 to Na-
6 than C. Vance of Wyoming for fire loss arising out of the
7 Mink Fire in and around Yellowstone National Park in
8 1988.

9 (b) SOURCE OF FUNDS.—The Secretary shall make
10 the payment pursuant to subsection (a) out of the regional
11 fire budget of the Forest Service prior to making any
12 other fire-related payment for fiscal year 1994.

1 (c) CONDITION OF PAYMENT.—The payment made
2 pursuant to subsection (a) shall be in full satisfaction of
3 all claims of Nathan C. Vance against the United States
4 for the fire loss described in subsection (a), including For-
5 est Service claim file number 6570.
