Mr. PELL (by request) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Foreign Relations

A BILL

To amend the Asian Development Bank Act to authorize consent to, and authorize appropriations for, the United States contribution to the fifth replenishment of the resources of the Asian Development Fund, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 That the Asian Development Bank Act (22 U.S.C. 285,

4 et seq.) is amended by adding at the end the following

5 new section:

6 “SEC. 31. (a) The United States Governor of the

7 Bank is authorized to contribute on behalf of the United

1 States \$680,000,000 to the Asian Development Fund, a
2 special fund of the Bank, except that any commitment to
3 make such contributions shall be made subject to obtain-
4 ing the necessary appropriations.

5 “(b) In order to pay for the United States contribu-
6 tion provided for in subsection (a), there are authorized
7 to be appropriated without fiscal year limitation,
8 \$680,000,000 for payment by the Secretary of the
9 Treasury.”.
