3 **SECTION 1. PROVISION OF FLUID MILK.**

4 Paragraph (2) of section 9(a) of the National School
5 Lunch Act (42 U.S.C. 1758(a)) is amended to read as
6 follows:

1 “(2) Lunches served by schools participating in the
2 school lunch program under this Act shall offer students
3 fluid milk.”.
