A BILL

To make the temporary suspension of duty on menthol feedstocks permanent.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PERMANENT DUTY-FREE TREATMENT.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 29 of the Harmonized
5 Tariff Schedule of the United States is amended by insert-
6 ing in numerical sequence the following new subheading
7 with the article description having the same degree of in-
8 dentation as the article description for subheading
9 2906.14.00:

“	2906.17.00	Mixtures containing not less than 90 percent by weight of stereoisomers of 2-isopropyl-5-methyl-cyclohexanol, but containing not more than 30 percent by weight of any one such stereoisomer	Free	Free (A, E, IL)	45%	”.

1 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Subchapter II of
2 chapter 99 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the Unit-
3 ed States is amended by striking heading 9902.29.05.

4 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
5 subsection (a) shall apply with respect to goods entered,
6 or withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
7 the date which is 15 days after the date of the enactment
8 of this Act.
