A BILL

To temporarily suspend the duty on 2-(4-Aminophenyl)-6-methyl-benzothiazole-7-sulfonic acid.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. 2-(4-AMINOPHENYL)-6-METHYL-BENZOTHIA-**
4 **ZOLE-7-SULFONIC ACID.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.29.78 in the Har-
6 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States is amended
7 by striking “12/31/90” and inserting “12/31/97”.

8 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—

9 (1) IN GENERAL.—The amendments made by
10 subsection (a) shall apply with respect to goods en-

1 tered, or withdrawn from warehouse for consump-
2 tion, on or after the date that is 15 days after the
3 date of the enactment of this Act.

4 (2) RETROACTIVE APPLICATION.—Notwith-
5 standing section 514 of the Tariff Act of 1930 or
6 any other provision of law, upon proper request filed
7 with the appropriate customs officer not later than
8 90 days after the date of the enactment of this Act,
9 any entry of an article described in heading
10 9902.29.78 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of
11 the United States that was made—

12 (A) after December 31, 1990, and

13 (B) before the date that is 15 days after
14 the date of the enactment of this Act,
15 shall be liquidated or reliquidated as though such
16 entry occurred on or after the date that is 15 days
17 after the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
