To temporarily suspend the duty on lauryllactam.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. LAURYLLACTAM.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
7 new heading:

“	9902.31.12	Lauryllactam (provided for in subheading 2933.79.50)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/97	”.

8 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
9 this section shall apply with respect to goods entered, or
