6 For purposes of national eligibility for the 1992 Com-
7 bined Federal Campaign, the Vietnam Veterans Assist-
8 ance Fund, Inc., a corporation incorporated under the

1 laws of the State of Delaware, shall be considered as hav-
2 ing met the requirements of section 618(b)(2)(A)(ii) of the
3 joint resolution entitled “A joint resolution making further
4 continuing appropriations for the fiscal year 1988, and for
5 other purposes”, approved December 22, 1987 (Public
6 Law 100–202; 101 Stat. 1329–423; 5 U.S.C. 1101 note).

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
