A BILL

For the relief of Wade Bomar.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 Notwithstanding section 1303 of Public Law 101-647,
4 Wade Bomar, of Billings, Montana, shall be eligible for
5 public safety officers' disability benefits under section
6 1201 of title I of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe
7 Streets Act of 1968 (42 U.S.C. 3796) to compensate for
8 injuries sustained in the line of duty on August 6, 1989,
9 while fighting the Pryor Gap fire, permanently depriving
10 him of the use of his limbs.
