## A BILL

To extend the deadline under the Federal Power Act applicable to the construction of a hydroelectric project in the State of Oregon.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2        *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3        **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF DEADLINE.**

4        Notwithstanding the time limitations of section 13 of  
5        the Federal Power Act, the Federal Energy Regulatory  
6        Commission, upon request of the licensee for FERC  
7        Project Numbered 7829 (and after reasonable notice), is  
8        authorized, in accordance with the good faith, due dili-  
9        gence, and public interest requirements of such section 13  
10       and the Commission's procedures under such section, to

1 extend the time required for commencement of construc-  
2 tion of such project for up to a maximum of two consecu-  
3 tive two-year periods. This section shall take effect for  
4 such project upon the expiration of the extension (issued  
5 by the Commission under such section 13) of the period  
6 required for commencement of construction of such  
7 project.
