A BILL

To amend the Bretton Woods Agreements Act to authorize consent to, and authorize appropriations for, the United States contribution to the Global Environment Facility, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the Bretton Woods Agreements Act (22 U.S.C. 285,
4 et seq.) is amended by adding at the end the following
5 new section:
6 “SEC. 61. (a) The Secretary of the Treasury is au-
7 thorized to contribute to the Global Environment Facility

1 \$30,810,000, subject to obtaining the necessary appro-
2 priations.

3 “(b) In order to pay for the United States contribu-
4 tion provided for in subsection (a), there are authorized
5 to be appropriated without fiscal year limitation,
6 \$30,810,000 for payment by the Secretary of the
7 Treasury.”.
