## A BILL

4 Section 2119 of title 18, United States Code, is

6 (1) by striking “, possessing a firearm as de-  
7 fined in section 921 of this title,”; and

1           (2) in paragraph (3) by striking “or imprisoned  
2           for any number of years or for life, or both” and in-  
3           serting “or punished by death or imprisoned for any  
4           term of years or for life, or both”.
