Mr. MITCHELL (for Mr. HEFLIN) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

For the relief of Richard Kanehl of Mobile, Alabama.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 SECTION 1. The Secretary of the Treasury shall pay,
4 out of any money in the Treasury not otherwise appro-
5 priated, the sum of \$6,563,000 to Richard Kanehl of Mo-
6 bile, Alabama, for damages incurred by the said Richard
7 Kanehl and the Dri-Mix Products Corporation of Mobile,
8 Alabama, when such corporation incurred involuntary
9 bankruptcy under chapter 7 of title 11, United States
10 Code, resulting from the termination of three related con-
11 tracts with the Federal Government.

1 SEC. 2. (a) The payment made pursuant to the first
2 section of this Act shall constitute full settlement of all
3 legal and equitable claims by Richard Kanehl of Mobile,
4 Alabama, against the United States.

5 (b) Nothing in this Act shall be construed as an infer-
6 ence of liability on the part of the United States.

7 SEC. 3. No part of the amount appropriated in this
8 Act in excess of 10 percent thereof shall be paid or deliv-
9 ered to or received by any agent or attorney on account
10 of services rendered in connection with this Act, and the
11 same shall be unlawful, any contract to the contrary not-
12 withstanding. Violation of the provisions of this section is
13 a misdemeanor punishable by a fine not to exceed \$1,000.
