## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on 1,8-Dichloroanthraquinone.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. 1,8-DICHLOROANTHRAQUINONE.**

4 Subchapter II of chapter 99 of the Harmonized Tar-  
5 iff Schedule of the United States is amended by inserting  
6 in numerical sequence the following new subheading:

“	9902.31.12	1,8-Dichloroanthraquinone (provided for in subheading 2914.70.20) .....	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/94	”.
