**AMENDMENTS**

***In the House of Representatives, U. S.,***

*March 23, 1993.*

*Resolved*, That the resolution from the Senate (S. Con. Res. 13) entitled “Concurrent resolution permitting the use of the rotunda of the Capitol for a ceremony to commemorate the days of remembrance of victims of the Holocaust”, do pass with the following

**AMENDMENTS:**

Strike out all after the resolving clause and insert:

1 *That the rotunda of the Capitol is authorized to be used*  
2 *from 8 o'clock ante meridiem until 3 o'clock post meridiem*  
3 *on April 20, 1993, and from 8 o'clock ante meridiem until*  
4 *3 o'clock post meridiem on April 6, 1994, for ceremonies*  
5 *as part of the commemoration of the days of remembrance*  
6 *of victims of the Holocaust. Physical preparations for the*  
7 *ceremonies shall be carried out in accordance with such con-*  
8 *ditions as the Architect of the Capitol may prescribe.*

Amend the preamble so as to read: “Whereas the United States Holocaust Memorial Council has designated April 18 through April 25, 1993, and April 3 through April 10, 1994, as “Days of Remembrance of Victims of the Holocaust”: Now, therefore, be it”.

Amend the title so as to read: “Concurrent resolution permitting the use of the rotunda of the Capitol for

ceremonies as part of the commemoration of the days of remembrance of victims of the Holocaust.”.
