Mr. MITCHELL submitted the following concurrent resolution; which was considered and agreed to

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To provide for the counting on January 6, 1993, of the electoral votes for President and Vice President of the United States.

1 *Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives*
2 *concurring)*, That the two Houses of Congress shall meet
3 in the Hall of the House of Representatives on Wednes-
4 day, the 6th day of January 1993, at 1 o'clock post merid-
5 ian, pursuant to the requirements of the Constitution and
6 laws relating to the election of President and Vice Presi-
7 dent of the United States, and the President of the Senate
8 shall be their Presiding Officer; that two tellers shall be
9 previously appointed by the President of the Senate on
10 the part of the Senate and two by the Speaker on the

1 part of the House of Representatives, to whom shall be
2 handed, as they are opened by the President of the Senate,
3 all the certificates and papers purporting to be certificates
4 of the electoral votes, which certificates and papers shall
5 be opened, presented, and acted upon in the alphabetical
6 order of the States, beginning with the letter "A"; and
7 said tellers, having then read the same in the presence
8 and hearing of the two Houses, shall make a list of the
9 votes as they shall appear from the said certificates; and
10 the votes having been ascertained and counted in the man-
11 ner and according to the rules by law provided, the result
12 of the same shall be delivered to the President of the Sen-
13 ate, who shall thereupon announce the state of the vote,
14 which announcement shall be deemed a sufficient declara-
15 tion of the persons, if any, elected President and Vice
16 President of the United States, and, together with a list
17 of the votes, be entered on the Journals of the two Houses.
