

In the House of Representatives, U. S.,

Resolved, That the resolution from the Senate (S. Con. Res. 39) entitled “Concurrent resolution to authorize the printing of a new annotated edition of Glenn Brown’s ‘History of the United States Capitol’, originally published in two volumes in 1900 and 1903, prepared under the auspices of the Architect of the Capitol”, do pass with the following

AMENDMENTS:

1 **(1)**Page 1, line 3, strike out “entitled” and all that
2 follows through “as” on line 4, and insert: *entitled “His-*
3 *tory of the United States Capitol”*, by Glenn Brown, as

4 **(2)**Page 1, strike out line 12 and all that follows
5 through page 2, line 2, and insert:

6 *SEC. 3. In addition to the usual number, there shall*
7 *be printed, for the use of the Senate and the House of Rep-*
8 *resentatives, the lesser of—*

9 *(1) 6,500 copies of the document, to be allocated*
10 *as determined jointly by the Secretary of the Senate*
11 *and the Clerk of the House of Representatives; or*

12 *(2) such number of copies of the document as*
13 *does not exceed a total production and printing cost*
14 *of \$112,265, with distribution to be allocated as de-*
15 *scribed in paragraph (1).*

Amend the title so as to read: “Concurrent resolution authorizing the printing of the book entitled ‘History of the United States Capitol’.”.
