## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1       *Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives*  
2 *concurring)*, That in the enrollment of the bill (H.R.  
3 2403), entitled “An Act making appropriations for the  
4 Treasury Department, the United States Postal Service,  
5 the Executive Office of the President, and certain Inde-  
6 pendent Agencies, for the fiscal year ending September 30,  
7 1994, and for other purposes” the Clerk of the House of  
8 Representatives is requested to make the following correc-  
9 tion:

10               In the matter under the heading:

11       “GENERAL SERVICES ADMINISTRATION FEDERAL  
12                               BUILDINGS FUND

13       “LIMITATIONS ON AVAILABILITY OF REVENUE”

14       under title IV under the heading “INDEPENDENT  
15       AGENCIES” strike out the following proviso: “:  
16       *Provided further*, That subject to the exceptions con-  
17       tained in the preceding proviso, in no case shall such  
18       funds be made available for any lease, line-item con-  
19       struction, repair, or alterations project referred to in

1 the preceding proviso if prior to February 1, 1994,  
2 the lease, line-item construction, repair, or alter-  
3 ations project has been disapproved by the House  
4 Committee on Public Works and Transportation and  
5 the Senate Committee on Environment and Public  
6 Works” and insert in lieu thereof “: *Provided fur-*  
7 *ther*, That subject to the exceptions contained in the  
8 preceding proviso, in no case shall such funds be  
9 made available for any lease, line-item construction,  
10 repair, or alterations project referred to in the pre-  
11 ceding proviso if prior to February 1, 1994, the  
12 lease, line-item construction, repair, or alterations  
13 project has been disapproved by the House Commit-  
14 tee on Public Works and Transportation or the Sen-  
15 ate Committee on Environment and Public Works”.
