## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To correct technical errors in the enrollment of the bill  
H.R. 2333.

1        *Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives*  
2        *concurring)*, That in the enrollment of the bill (H.R. 2333)  
3        to authorize appropriations for the Department of State,  
4        the United States Information Agency, and related agen-  
5        cies, and for other purposes, the Clerk of the House of  
6        Representatives shall make the following corrections:

7                (1) In section 201(a) after paragraph (6) insert  
8        the following new paragraph:

9                “(7) TITLE V OF PUBLIC LAW 98–164.—To  
10        carry out title V of Public Law 98–164,

1       \$35,000,000 for the fiscal year 1994 and  
2       \$35,000,000 for the fiscal year 1995.”.

3           (2) In section 140(a)(2), before the period at  
4       the end of the first sentence insert: “, to recover the  
5       costs of providing consular services”.

6           (3) In section 201(a)(1), strike “\$473,488,000”  
7       and insert: “\$487,988,000” and strike  
8       “\$480,362,000” and insert: ”\$494,862,000”.

9           (4) In section 101(b)(2), insert the following  
10       new subparagraph (F):

11           “(F) \$2,000,000 is authorized to be appro-  
12       priated for fiscal year 1995 for computer up-  
13       grades for the Bureau of Intelligence and Re-  
14       search.”.

15           (5) In section 516, strike “Senate” and insert:  
16       “Congress”.

17           (6) In the table of contents, strike “Sec. 249”  
18       and insert: “Sec. 239” immediately before “Increas-  
19       ing African participation in USIA exchange pro-  
20       grams.”.
