CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 *Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives*
2 *concurring)*, That there shall be printed as a Senate docu-
3 ment “U.S. Senator Robert C. Byrd’s Addresses to the
4 United States Senate on the History of Roman Constitu-
5 tionalism”, delivered between May 5, 1993 and October
6 18, 1993.

7 SEC. 2. The document referred to in the first section
8 shall be—

9 (1) published under the supervision of the Sec-
10 retary of the Senate; and

11 (2) in such style, form, manner, and binding as
12 directed by the Joint Committee on Printing, after
13 consultation with the Secretary of the Senate.

14 The document shall include illustrations.

15 SEC. 3. In addition to the usual number of copies
16 of the document, there shall be printed the lesser of—

17 (1) 5,000 copies for the use of the Secretary of
18 Senate; or

1 (2) such number of copies as does not exceed
2 a total production and printing cost of \$47,864.
