## JOINT RESOLUTION

Proposing a constitutional amendment to limit congressional terms.

1        *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*  
2        *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3        That the following article is proposed as an amendment  
4        to the Constitution of the United States, which shall be  
5        valid to all intents and purposes as part of the Constitu-  
6        tion if ratified by the legislatures of three-fourths of the  
7        several States within seven years after its submission for  
8        ratification:
