AMENDMENTS

In the House of Representatives, U. S.,

March 23, 1993.

Resolved, That the resolution from the Senate (S.J. Res. 28) entitled “Joint resolution to provide for the appointment of Barber B. Conable, Jr., as a citizen regent of the Board of Regents of the Smithsonian Institution”, do pass with the following

AMENDMENTS:

Strike out all after the resolving clause and insert:

1 *That, in accordance with section 5581 of the Revised Stat-*
2 *utes of the United States (20 U.S.C. 43), the vacancy on*
3 *the Board of Regents of the Smithsonian Institution, in the*
4 *class other than Members of Congress, occurring by reason*
5 *of the expiration of the term of Barnabas McHenry of New*
6 *York on July 21, 1991, is filled by the appointment of Bar-*
7 *ber B. Conable, Jr. of New York. The appointment is for*
8 *a term of 6 years and shall take effect on the date on which*
9 *this joint resolution becomes law.*

Amend the title so as to read: “Joint resolution providing for the appointment of Barber B. Conable, Jr., as

a citizen regent of the Board of Regents of the Smithsonian Institution.”.
