**JOINT RESOLUTION**

To provide for the appointment of Barber B. Conable, Jr., as a citizen regent of the Board of Regents of the Smithsonian Institution.

1       *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*  
 2       *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
 3       That in accordance with section 5581 of the Revised Stat-  
 4       utes of the United States (20 U.S.C. 43), a vacancy on  
 5       the Board of Regents of the Smithsonian Institution, in

1 the class other than Members of Congress, shall be filled  
2 by the appointment of Barber B. Conable, Jr., of New  
3 York. The appointment is for a term of 6 years and shall  
4 take effect upon the date of approval of this resolution.
