Mr. HATCH introduced the following joint resolution; which was read twice
and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

JOINT RESOLUTION

To designate the week of April 18, 1993, through April
24, 1993, as “International Student Awareness Week”.

Whereas international student exchange programs provide
students with an enriched and improved quality of life
through first-hand experience with different cultures;

Whereas international student exchange programs provide
fertile training ground for future world leaders;

Whereas international student exchange programs make enor-
mous strides toward world peace through understanding;

Whereas international student exchange programs enrich a
student’s understanding of the United States and its
communities; and

Whereas the United States recognizes the need for an increased awareness of such valuable programs: Now, therefore, be it

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the week of April 18, 1993, through April 24, 1993,
4 is designated as “International Student Awareness
5 Week”. The President is authorized and requested to issue
6 a proclamation calling upon the people of the United
7 States to observe the week with appropriate ceremonies
8 and activities.
