1 *Resolved*, That the bill (S. 1325) entitled “A bill for
2 the relief of Horace Martin”, now pending in the Senate,
3 together with all accompanying papers, is referred to the
4 Chief Judge of the United States Claims Court. The Chief
5 Judge shall proceed with the same in accordance with the
6 provisions of sections 1492 and 2509 of title 28, United
7 States Code, and report back to the Senate, at the earliest
8 practicable date, giving such finding of fact and conclu-
9 sions that are sufficient to inform Congress of the amount,
